### Exciting Announcement: Welcome, Jay Roy!



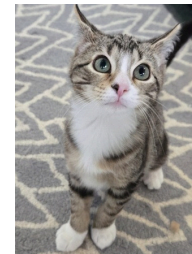
We are thrilled to announce **Jay Roy** as our new Adoption Center Manager. Many of you may know Jay from his years at Roy's IGA in Caribou or his time at McCains. But you might not know his rescue history. Years ago, Jay and his father, Ernest, cared for a colony of 70 cats behind the IGA! That is where he first partnered with Norma to trap, sterilize, and rehabilitate them.

When Norma's health recently presented challenges, Jay stepped up—first as a volunteer, and now as our Manager. It is a reunion of kindred spirits. As Jay told us: "I work for a cause, not applause."

Our volunteers describe his arrival as a "booster shot" of energy for the rescue. With Jay's deep knowledge of animal care and heart for the mission, we are ready for the next chapter.

### Can We Get a Home for the Holidays?

This Fall in September and October, we helped **37 kittens and cats find homes**. But the work isn't over. Just two days ago more kittens arrived. These two babies are waiting for adoption at the Adoption Center. All their medical is completed. We want to get them adopted soon so they can experience their first Christmas with bows, decorations, and love.

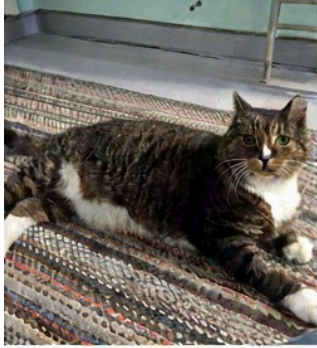

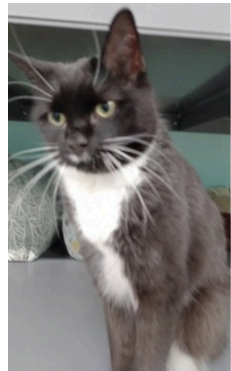

**Cheyenne:** Abandoned with a large facial cyst when her family broke up, she received the surgery she needed and has been adopted!

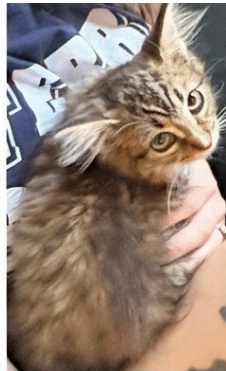
## The "Special Souls"
